

Page 32: Clubs in action

Yeşilköy: The club organized a painting contest at the school for children with a vocational handicap. Two computers, two tablets, two guitars were given as prize to the students who got the first six place in the competition. (p.32)



Guinness World Record by Güney Rotary

Güney: The largest paper mosaic built from A4 size paper, depicting a quest for peace was built by the club in front of the main train station of the city of Adana. There were 17,800 individual paintings that were put together to form the mosaic and the project was completed in 210 days. 279 participants from 84 different schools and institutions turned this project into reality. The arbiter of Guinness Records was present during the completion of the project and register it as part of a new world record. (p.33)

Karadeniz: Clothing Festival project of the club has gain great inertia with the help of the D.2420 and Atakum Rotary Club. More than 3,250 students received clothing thanks to the project. The project that started in 2010 in District 2420, has been providing students living in different parts of the country with clothing that the organization gathers through donations and sponsorships of clothing companies. Since its inception, more than 46,000 students benefited from this activity. (p.34)

Atakum: The project of Atakum Rotary club comprises 12 living units with one bedroom in an apartment building whose construction started during 2010–11 Rotary year and continued until its completion at the end of April this year. The project aims to provide housing for a period of 6 months to children coming from distant areas to receive leukemia treatment at a nearby center and whose families are in need. The club does not charge any money for the lodgings. The whole construction cost was around \$450,000. (p.33)



Seyhan: An 8,000 square feet multipurpose sports building has been constructed within the premises of Seyhan Rotary Anadolulı Lycée that can hold 400 spectators. The construction started in September 2012 and was completed in less than a year in April 2013. The building will be used for different sportive activities of the students and will be able to house different activities such as stage shows, meetings and seminars. The necessary funding for the construction has been provided by different activities of the club as well as the donations from sponsors. The building was named after Ismail Kulak, a Rotarian of the club who passed away recently. (p.35)

Edremit: The book and toy piggybank, realized by the joint efforts of the club and the Municipality of Edremit was officially installed at the 25th anniversary of the club. The books and toys that will be put into the piggybank will be gathered by the Municipality and distributed according to demands in the region. (p.36)

Uludağ: In order to provide vocational training to mildly handicapped children, the club donated a complete line of sewing machines to Rüveyde Dörtçelik school for handicapped students. In this workshop, the students will be thought courses that will provide them an opportunity to work at companies in the garment industry, a large industrial sector in the area. (p.38)
